OKLAHOMA STATE 68, OKLAHOMA 66 JANUARY 30, 2017 • POSTGAME NOTES

- Oklahoma (8-13, 2-7 Big 12) fell in the first Bedlam meeting of the 2016-17 season, 68-66, at Lloyd Noble Center. Oklahoma State (14-8, 3-6 Big 12) snapped OU's seven-game Bedlam winning streak with its first win over the Sooners since Feb. 26, 2013. Monday's loss also snapped a 12-game Oklahoma home winning streak over the Cowboys. Oklahoma State had not won in Norman since 2004.
 - The Sooners now own a 9-3 record against Oklahoma State during the Lon Kruger era and a 136-96 all-time advantage in Bedlam.
 - Freshman guard **Kameron McGusty** led the Sooners with a career-high 22 points, four rebounds, two assists and one steal. McGusty has totaled 20 points on three occasions this seasons – all within the past seven games. McGusty's three 20-point games are the most by an OU freshman since **Jordan Woodard** (also had three). The guard leads all Big 12 freshmen in scoring during Big 12 play with 15.8 points.
 - McGusty has scored in double-digits in nine consecutive outings – the longest such streak by a Sooner this season. He has scored at least 10 points in every game during the month of January.
 - Sophomore forward **Dante Buford** scored 11 of Oklahoma's 22 bench points. Buford's season-high 11 points came on 3-of-5 shooting (2-of-4 from 3-point range) alongside five boards and a pair of steals.
 - Junior forward **Khadeem Lattin** registered a season-high six blocks to go with eight points. He has swatted at least five shots in three games season and is averaging 2.8 blocks per contest in Big 12 play. In 92 career games, Lattin has recorded 154 blocks – the fourth most in Sooner history.
 - Up next, the Sooners head to West Texas for a Saturday night showdown with Texas Tech on Feb. 4. The Sooners and Red Raiders will tip off at 6 p.m. CT on ESPNU.
 - Oklahoma owns a 38-22 lead in the all-time series. The Sooners have won seven of the last nine meetings, including an 84-75 victory earlier this month in Norman. Tech holds a 14-13 advantage when playing in Lubbock. OU is 8-3 against Tech in the Kruger era and holds a 3-2 record in Lubbock under Kruger.
