OU POSTGAME NOTES

GENERAL NOTES

- Oklahoma fell to 46-62-5 all-time against Texas, and 13-10 against the Longhorns during the Big 12 era. The 113 meetings are the most for the Sooners against another opponent.
- The Sooners fell to 25-3 overall as the No. 7 team in the AP poll.
- Oklahoma's loss Saturday was only its second in its last 29 games against Big 12 competition, dating back to the 2015 season.
- Oklahoma scored 21 points in the fourth quarter, matching its highest fourth-quarter total in series history. The last time the Sooners scored 21 fourth-quarter points against Texas was in 1952.
- WR Marquise Brown's 77-yard touchdown reception from QB Kyler Murray in the third quarter stands as Oklahoma's longest-ever pass play against Texas.
- Texas' 48 points were the most it has scored against OU in the series.
- The 93 combined points are the most in series history, eclipsing the 85 combined points (OU 45, Texas 40) in 2016.
- For the first time in series history, both Oklahoma (532) and Texas (501) gained over 500 total yards of offense. The Longhorns surpassed 500 yards for just the second time ever against Oklahoma. OU outgained the Longhorns 9.2 yards per play to 6.7.
- The Sooners have scored at least 30 points in 28 of their last 30 games, and have lost just three of those 30.
- Oklahoma trailed Texas 24-17 at the half, facing its first halftime deficit of the season. OU's 17 points were its fewest in the first half this season.
- Today's attendance of 92,300 marked a sellout. It was the seventh-largest attendance figure in series history.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

QB KYLER MURRAY

- Finished 19 of 26 passing for 304 yards and four touchdowns (214.4 passer rating). It was his fourth game this season with at least 300 passing yards.
- Has thrown for at least three touchdowns in five straight games, and has multiple passing touchdowns in each game this season (two vs. Florida Atlantic, three vs. UCLA, three at Iowa State, three vs. Army, six vs. Baylor and four vs. Texas).
- He has accounted for 26 total touchdowns this season (21 passing, five rushing).
- His 77-yard touchdown pass to WR Marquise Brown in the third quarter was Oklahoma's longest-ever pass play against Texas.
- Scored his fifth rushing touchdown of the season on a 67-yard run in the fourth quarter. It was his longest career rushing play. He has scored a rushing touchdown in three straight games.
- His 67-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter was the longest TD run by an OU quarterback against Texas since Jack Mitchell's 72-yard TD run in 1947.

WR MARQUISE BROWN

- Finished with 131 yards and two touchdowns on nine receptions. It was his eighth career 100-yard receiving game.
- The 13th Sooner to record a 100-yard receiving game against Texas (13 total occurrences).
- Scored touchdowns on receptions of four and 77 yards. It was his second multiple-TD game of the season (second straight) and the third of his career. He now has 14 career receiving touchdowns and seven this season.
- Secured OU's longest-ever reception against Texas with his 77-yard touchdown catch from Murray in the third quarter.
- Has five career touchdowns of 75 yards or longer.
- Has seven catches of at least 40 yards this season. He entered the game leading the nation in catches of at least 40 yards.
- His 77-yard touchdown reception was his 12th reception of at least 50 yards in his 20 games as a Sooner (ninth of at least 50 yards for a touchdown). Since the start of the 2017 season, he leads the nation with 12 catches of at least 50 yards.

WR CEEDEE LAMB

- Finished with 75 yards and a touchdown on six receptions.
- Scored his fifth touchdown of the season and 12th of his career with a 5-yard reception from QB Kyler Murray with 28 seconds left in the second quarter.

WR LEE MORRIS

- Scored his sixth career touchdown and fourth of the season on a 19-yard pass from QB Kyler Murray in the fourth quarter. He now has six TDs on 10 career receptions.

RB TREY SERMON

- Scored his third rushing touchdown of the season and the eighth of his career on a game-tying 7-yard run with 2:38 remaining in the fourth quarter.

K AUSTIN SEIBERT

- Scored nine points in the game to raise his career scoring total to 414 points. He moved into 16th place in NCAA career scoring among kickers.
- Has registered 31 straight touchbacks (eight today), dating back to the end of the UCLA game. He has 43 touchbacks on 45 kickoffs this season. The only two returns went for 15 yards each (one each vs. FAU and UCLA).

LB CURTIS BOLTON

- Registered a game-high 13 tackles to lead OU in stops for the first time this season. It was his third double-digit tackle game this year (third straight).
- Logged one of OU's three sacks on the day, good for a 12-yard loss, and two quarterback hurries. He has 2.5 sacks on the year.

LB KENNETH MURRAY

- Recorded 10 tackles, good for his fourth straight double-digit tackle game. He is averaging 16.3 tackles per game during that span.
